Shauna Abbott provided a financial update showing that November of 2025 sales were only \$2,331.70 higher than 2024 and our year-to-date revenue for 2025 is higher by 2.2% or just over \$174,500.

Shauna Abbott reported on the expenses that the power bill expense for November is \$40,495.73 higher than the year before while the all in power cost is lower by (1%) \$50,209.83 over 2024. The YTD Total Cost of Electric Services (TCOES) is \$89,836.14 higher than 2024. For the month of November 2025, the TCOES is higher by \$16,470.64 compared to the same month a year ago.

Abbott discussed the margins for November 2025 showing a net decrease of almost 15% of (\$16,161.65) when compared to November of 2024. Year to date, Chimney Rock's Margins are currently at \$414,084.84 which is \$106,957.22 over the prior year margins of \$307,127.62.

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Joel Duffield provided the Operators Report stating that in November CRPPD installed seven new services: three residentials, two single phase small commercial and two three phase small commercial.

Ron Hubbard disclosed that November marks the completion of the "CRPPD Work Order Process" guide. The guide is a way to keep our current Work Order Processes, including the new Springboard program, and the flow of paperwork as it passes through our system.

Joel Duffield reported on the Job Training and Safety Committee Meeting held on November 21, 2025. The group has a Classroom and field training with Tri-State Instructor for proper switching procedures. Duffield said it was very beneficial for the new employees to switch out one of the substations and go through random scenarios that may occur during switching.
